# Adopt a county road

## Volunteer groups sought

Make 2019 the year you plan to make a difference in the world around you, all while spending more time outdoors, getting fresh air and exercise.

Porter County Recycling & Waste Reduction is seeking volunteer groups to participate in the Adopt-A-County-Road Program. Community groups, businesses and even families can pledge to clean two mile stretches of unincorporated county roads and properly dispose of waste.

Groups will earn prominently placed recognition signs on their adopted sections of roads to acknowledge their hard work.

Funded by the Porter County Commissioners, this road cleanup program is similar to the State Highway "Adopt-a-Highway" program. Porter County Recycling provides the trash bags and collects the waste at the end of each outing. The district also provides safety vests and "Working Ahead" and "Slow" signs to alert drivers that cruise past work sites.

"We have found some families and groups are already cleaning roads on their own," said Therese Haller, executive director of Porter County Recycling. "We want people to know we'll help them with supplies and caution signs and give them the recognition they deserve."

In 2018, Adopt-A-County-Road participants, consisting of 124 volunteers and PACT workers, cleaned more than 125.5 miles of county roads and collected 304 bags of trash. Participants included Rigg Roadies; Keen family and friends; Friends of Portage Twp. Foundation, Inc.; 200 E. Neighbors; Taylor Family Farms; Lake of the Woods Club; Kouts Lions; Sue and Rob Klett; and the Shanta and Kosky families.

memories. We all have a circle of friends and family that will also be grieving and that need a chance to say goodbye. Believe me, there is nothing that shouts louder than a parent or child or spouse or friend is gone that to see them lying in state.

Arrangements that funeral homes and cemeteries provide are based on the cumulative needs of any given population. In NW Indiana, seventy percent of the population still wants a traditional funeral service followed by interment or entombment in a cemetery. The other 30 percent select cremation. Sometimes cremation is chosen because of money, sometimes for religious reasons and sometimes for ecological reasons. Regardless, many of those that go with cremation still want and still need a chance to say a proper goodbye.
